Hatice Yayla Awarded Sons of Norway's Nancy Lorraine Jensen Scholarship

Yayla is a first year student at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology in Trondheim, Norway. In the fall, she plans to continue her studies at Wellesley college in Massachusetts. Yayla hopes to eventually pursue a Ph.D. in chemistry and become a research scientist. Her grandmother is a member of Idun Lodge 5-074.
